

## WORLD TRUMPET MISSION – PRAYER TEACHINGS

### 11- COMBAT IN THE HEAVENLIES Praying For Israel & Her Destiny

#### Introduction

We are taking an important variation in our line of teachings on spiritual warfare. I believe that praying for Israel is a crucial part of strategic combat in the heavenlies. This teaching is to help us understand the crucial need to pray for Israel in these days. I want to encourage you that praying for Israel is not an addition to our inheritance in salvation. It is part and parcel of our inheritance as individuals, the Body of Christ and whole nations:

#### Our Inheritance Is Tied Up In Israel

Deuteronomy 32.<sup>8-9</sup>

*When the most High divided to the nations their inheritance, when he separated the sons of Adam, he set the bounds of the people according to the number of the children of Israel. For the LORD'S portion is his people; Jacob is the lot of his inheritance.*

First the scripture tells us that the Most High God is the One who divided the people into their nations and gave a portion of inheritance to each nation. He gave them their boundaries according to the number of the children of Israel. So whichever nation we are in, we are divided into our own nations according to the children of Israel. Israel is the portion God took as His inheritance. This is a mystery we need to ask God to reveal to us that **even before salvation, all nations on earth lived where they were, were what they were, according to the number of the sons of Israel.** That is how God apportioned the nations to be. Because of that, we have therefore an open door through Jesus Christ to become heirs together in the inheritance that God apportioned to Israel.

In the New Testament, Paul talks about it in Romans 11:15-21

*For if the casting away of them be the reconciling of the world, what shall the receiving of them be, but life from the dead? for if the firstfruit be holy, the lump is also holy: and if the root be holy, so are the branches. And if some of the branches be broken off, and thou, being a wild olive tree, wert grafted in among them, and with them partakest of the root and fatness of the olive tree; Boast not against the branches. But if thou boast, thou bearest not the root, but the root thee. Thou wilt say then, The branches were broken off, that I might be grafted in. Well; because of unbelief they were broken off, and thou standest by faith. Be not highminded, but fear: For if God spared not the natural branches, take heed lest he also spare not thee.*

He says 'We were the wild branches they are the natural branches. Because of unbelief they have been cast off for a season. The wild branches are grafted in.' He says they are not cut off forever. If their casting off opened a door for our adoption what will their restoration be? It will be resurrection from the dead.

I want to give you this little encouragement that praying for Israel, identifying with Israel is not a privilege or burden. It is part of the mystery of God dealing with His people. **Israel is not a nation that God picked, it is a nation He produced.** He did not look around and choose one out of the selection of nations that were already in existence. He took a man and said 'Out of you I will make a nation. **That nation has a destiny to bless the nations of the world.**' So that nation was raised specifically for us. It was not picked among nations it was produced. God picked that man and said 'Come out of your people, your country, your father's household, I will make you a nation and through that nation, I will bless the nations of the world.' **Israel was raised for the nations for the world. Every nation of the earth has a connection with Israel because their redemptive purpose concerns us.**

Before God called Abraham, there was a total breakdown of communication between God and the nations of the world at that time. The people worshipped other demon gods and practiced all kind of wickedness. God decided 'If these nations choose other demon-gods

which are not God, I cannot speak to them and compete with the voice of demon-gods. They don't know Me, they cannot understand when I speak to them. If I try to communicate to them in any way, they shall compute it and process what I require in their own corrupted mindset. They will see Me through a veiled, colored world-view and it brings about a confusing and terrible mixture. Therefore, I will raise up a nation and I will be the God of that nation. They will be My people, I will do things with this nation to show the nations of the world that there is no other god but the God of Israel. This nation of Israel will be a platform, to reveal Me to the nations of the world."

So God, through Abraham, raised Israel. He let other nations worship what they wanted to, but to Israel He said 'You will be My people, I will be your God. I want to show all nations what the God of Israel can do to a people whom He considers His own, a people who have accepted and submitted to His sovereign rule over them, how He relates to His people, how He is faithful to His people and keeps them in line with His nature.' **God raised Israel to be a banner to the nations that God may reveal to the world Who He Is.** At the right time after thousands of years after God had revealed Himself through His dealings with the nation of Israel, He sent His Son Jesus to die for the world of sinners; in a way God was saying to the nations of the world 'You have seen there is no better God than the God of Israel. Maybe you feel you are not part of privilege of being Israel, but now the door is open. You can be adopted into the family of Israel. You can call upon Me as Abba Father. You who were not a people can become My people. You who did not seek Me, I came to seek you.' After revealing Himself among the nations through Israel, He gave all the nations of the world, an opportunity to join the family of Israel. Today, God has revealed Himself to us through His son Jesus Christ. Everyone, Jew or gentile must receive redemption and salvation through Jesus Christ to qualify to become children of God for *as many as received Him He gave them the power to become children of God* (John 1.12)

There is a scenario we need to understand. Many times people with 'Replacement Theology' say 'The Jews killed Jesus therefore God rejected them,' and many other such arguments that I am not focussing on in this discourse. Incidentally that is not in the Bible. We have seen that the Bible says God rejected them because of their unbelief and hardness of heart.' But, is that ground for God to reject Israel forever? Could we say we gentiles are selected because we are better believers than Israel? Haven't we done everything and even more, than what Israel was rejected for? Let us remember the following things:

- The early church was primarily made up of Jews
- All apostle were Jews
- All the pioneer groups of men and women who went preaching to the gentile nations were Jews.

#### **Before Christ Was Given Up God Gave Israel Up That We Might Enter Into The Kingdom**

If that is not enough to touch the heart of God, and we think we have done better, we must realize we believe a lie - however this was a plan of God even before Jesus came. Isaiah was the prince of prophets. He made many very detailed prophecies about Jesus Christ and these last days. All of His prophecies about Jesus Christ, His birth, life, passion, and death came to pass to the dot. His prophecies about the nation of Israel, its dispersion among the nations and the return back to their promised land also came to pass. Many other of his prophecies have also come to pass in these last days. In Isaiah 6, Isaiah saw the Lord and heard Him speak words of destiny in V<sup>8-11</sup>:

*Also I heard the voice of the Lord, saying, Whom shall I send, and who will go for us? Then said I, Here am I; send me. And he said, **Go, and tell these people,** Hear ye indeed, but understand not; and see ye indeed, but perceive not. Make the heart of this people fat, and make their ears heavy, and shut their eyes; lest they see with their eyes, and hear with their ears, and understand with their heart, and convert, and be healed. Then said I, Lord, how long? And he answered, 'Until the cities be wasted without inhabitant, and the houses without man, and the land be utterly desolate' (KJV)*

When God instructed Him and said *go and tell these people*, which people was God speaking about? **The people of Israel.** Isaiah asked *for how long* would this veil of blindness and hardness of heart be upon the people? God said *until the land is utterly forsaken.* (NIV)

Isaiah saw the Lord and realized he was sinful and lived among sinful people, and he began to lament over this situation. God did not judge him. He sent an angel to purify him with coal from the altar of the Lord. Then he heard the voice say 'Whom shall we send and who will go for us?' He said "Go and tell your people 'they will be hearing and not understand, they will see and not perceive and even their heart will be hardened and their eyes made dull for they may listen and hear they might see and perceive and their hearts may respond to Me and I will heal them.'"

What is God saying? He says "I want to hold them back so I want to close their ears eyes and heart. If I do not do that they will turn to Me and I will heal them. I have given them much opportunity that I can reveal Myself to the nation through them. I want them to stay somewhere that I may open the door to the gentiles." At the end of Isaiah 6 God gives hope of a "Holy seed" (ref. Gal. 3.16) and in Isaiah 7 we see Isaiah giving King Ahaz the sign of Emmanuel – the coming Messiah, a theme he continues over and over through the entire book of Isaiah. **God did not only give us Jesus Christ, but He gave up as it were, the nation of His chosen people Israel so we may have a way to be adopted. He cut them off. Before they had Jesus Christ, before they rejected Jesus Christ, the Father had already said 'let their eyes see and not perceive.....'**

Then Jesus came and repeated those very words, even Paul when he was out on mission he preached to the Jews, and they did not receive him and he said 'It is because of the prophecy that was spoken over you. You will see but not perceive, hear but not understand. Your heart will be hardened that we may turn to the gentiles. The Bible says "And many gentiles believed on the Lord."

We do not only love Jesus who gave His life for us but we love the Father whom, after raising a nation for which He was God and they His people; when He wanted to adopt us, He put them aside. He is the One who hardened their hearts, closed their eyes and ears that we may have an opportunity to come into the family of God. Paul the Apostle even said, '*When the fullness of the gentiles has fully come in, then the door will be open again for the Jews and all the remnant, will be saved.* In other words, it is not about their stubbornness. If God is able to make all of them come to Him then the problem is not their stubborn heart, the issue is God and His timing.

**When you realize that a people who have a natural inheritance in Him have been closed out, that you may come in, and in that process, they are dying, there are those who die in their blindness without the Messiah, in rejection of the Messiah. Why? Is it because you are better than them?** Because they were closed out that the fullness of gentiles may come in. When you realize that sacrifice, don't you feel a heavy debt to pray for them?

### **God's Divine Justice**

Read through the three chapters of Habakkuk. Today, many people, including well meaning Christians are so bound by our world systems; especially the democratic system and we begin to compute that heaven operates by the transient standards of this world. Therefore today, many people will argue with God's dealing with Israel. We reason with God's dealings with His creation and try to democratize the Kingdom of God. When we cannot make sense of His dealings, we decide to create our own judgments to explain why God has dealt with Israel or another people or nation – thus theories like 'replacement theology' and other secular humanistic explanations from the human reasoning are concocted. However, this may be hard to swallow, but our God rules as a righteous, just, holy Autocratic King over His Kingdom.

Briefly, Habakkuk's prophesy deals with the prophet's uncertainties regarding divine holiness and justice in light of a world that is permeated by godlessness and injustice. As we read through the book we find he was having spiritual searching of his heart. He was trapped in a sinful society; his faith was wavering so that he confronted God about His inactivity in the face

of the prevailing corruption. God answered Habbakuk in a way that troubled his soul even more. He heard the Lord say 'go and prophesy to the Israelites that I will give them into exile because of their sin. They have sinned so much. I will uproot them from the Promised Land and cast them away into another land.' Habakkuk was trembling. Then he heard God say 'Now stand up and prophesy to Chaldeans, the Babylonians, those wicked mighty warriors those who are quick to use the sword, who are ruthless and have no mercy. I am raising them up to come against my people and they will take them into captivity and keep them there for 70 years.'

How could God use the Chaldeans, a nation more wicked than Israel as an instrument of judgment of Israel? Habbakuk said, "Wait my Lord, the Chaldeans? The Babylonians? Those wicked, sinful people? Those wicked Idolaters are the ones You will use to judge Your people? What better are they? How can you give Israel over to the hand of Babylonians?"

As he continued to seek God, God revealed to the prophet the standards of His justice. He told Habakkuk of the judgment that would come to the Chaldeans in light of the operation of divine government. God basically told him "After 70 years I will redeem the Jews, then I will turn on the Babylonians and judge them for everything terrible they do to the Jews and utterly strike them for what they have done to My people.' Driven to prayer, Habakkuk was allowed to see God's justice in action in the past liberation of Israel from its oppression and His victorious leading of them to the land of promise.

That is why in Romans 11 Paul continues to say "You gentiles, I don't want you to feel proud that the Jews were cut away and you are in-grafted then you think you are better than them, ***because the calling and giftings of God are irrevocable.*** God did not call them and then forget them. The call of God is irreversible. So God may judge them and even allow you to be used to do it. But, after you have done your lot, He will judge you." Whatever the Jews are going through today, we do not know and do not fully understand the plan of God - **but whatever the Jews go through, let us not be part of the judging hand, let us not be part of the judging lips and the judging heart.** Let us pray for Israel and the Jewish people.

#### **Salvation Is An Inheritance OF The Jews**

Jesus said to the Samaritan, "You worship what you do not know but we Jews worship what we know. Salvation is OF the Jews." You cannot rejoice in salvation and hate the Jews when you are literally touching something that belongs to them. Salvation is not **FROM** the Jews, it is **OF** the Jews - It is their inheritance. For example, imagine a man who has His only begotten son whom he loves. The son becomes rebellious and runs away. In the home of that man there is also an adopted son who had been picked from the streets and adopted into the family. He was brought to the man's home and taken in as a son also. The man looks after him as a Father and the boy is obedient and loving to the man unlike his biological son who has gone away. Every time the adopted son comes home from school with a good report he says, "Daddy look how well I have done. I worked hard. Don't you love me? You can forget about the other son. I am a good son am I not? You can have me now instead of the rebellious one; after all he did XYZ to you. You can give me all the inheritance, don't consider him any more. I don't think he is even interested in coming back." If you were the father who genuinely loves your lost son, how would you feel? You'd feel like casting this adopted one away too.

God loves you as a gentile believer, but He will not forget His first born among the nations - Israel. He grieves and cries for the day the prodigal will return; the day that lost boy will say 'I sinned against You. I want to come back.' The Father loves the adopted son but does not forget the biological son. He has vowed that one day He will bring him back. Wouldn't you join the Father when you see His eyes gazing into the horizon, lost in thought, and you know He is thinking of that son, wondering how he is, how he longs to speak to Him that He may hear? Isn't it proper to join him in crying for that son to come back? We need to pray for Israel. We need to pray for the fullness of the gentiles to come quickly. We need to pray for our nations in relation to Israel and the full revelation of Her Messiah.

### **The Way Forward**

How do we pray? There are a lot of directions. There are many great men and women of God whom God has given wonderful and clear teachings about Israel and how to pray for her. Many wonderful teachings and books on praying for Israel are available and I recommend resources by Tom Hess - you may enquire from [jhopfan@jhopfan.org](mailto:jhopfan@jhopfan.org) Jerusalem House of Prayer For All Nations at [www.jhopfan.org](http://www.jhopfan.org) who are linked to various houses of prayer all around the world that pray for Israel. ### **The devil's Strategy**

The first thing we experience while praying for Israel is warfare, so expect it. The first time I was sent to Israel the Lord told me the enemy had two strategies he uses to hinder nations from their redemptive purposes in God:

- The first is hardships, war and trauma, trouble, sickness, poverty, ignorance and oppression, so that people feel God does not care for them and they reject Him. Half of the nations of the world are under this kind of bondage.
- The other strategy is ease and slumber, comfort and decadence, abundance, much affluence and human wisdom; where people are not lacking in anything physical, but the comfort and affluence goes into their heads and they begin to think they can do without God. They reject His way, devise their own rights and wrongs, expect God to be subject to their whims and style of living, and end up being separate from their own destiny in God. The other part of the world is under this bondage

These are two separate strategies but they serve the same purpose - keeping people away from God's destiny and redemptive purpose for their nations. God told me about Israel, 'It is one nation where both strategies are at work.' The hardship and oppression, the bloodshed and trouble in Israel and all the war and threat, and on the other hand, the ease, slumber and human wisdom Israel is in the same bracket as western world and the same spirit of secular humanism, slumber and many rejecting God is at work in Israel.

### **Rebirth of Israel's Redemptive Purpose & Destiny**

God gave me a clear prophetic word over the nation of Israel in 1996. In the prophetic word God showed there will be a mighty wind that will blow over Israel and a mighty shaking. In this shaking there will be a breaking of everything the Jewish people trust in and every pillar they lean upon. The Lord will slowly break it away. Every friend of Israel, including the USA will abandon Israel and she will remain alone. And all the strength of Israel, military prowess, finance, the wisdom they depend upon will let them down. In the end when they realize there is no hope anywhere, there will be a greater cry to the Lord, crying for the Messiah to come and in that period the Lord will open their hearts to know the Christ that was rejected is indeed the Messiah.

It will bring fresh revelation of who Christ is - not only to Jews but also to the entire world. In all the nations of the world, we have distorted the character of Jesus Christ. We see Him through veils and veils, history has distorted the image of Who Christ is. Today even the most sincere people seeking God have a contorted image of Who Christ is. **God raised up Israel in the days of Abraham that through them, He may reveal Himself to the nations.** For 2000 years after Jesus Christ, Israel was not a nation at all. They were scattered into all the nations of the world as the prophets said. About 60 years ago, God raised up Israel again. He brought them back to their land – one of the greatest fulfilments of prophecy today. **They are back on the platform. The destiny of Israel is to be a banner, a platform for God to reveal Himself to the nations. WE ARE IN FOR A FRESH REVELATION - God revealing Himself to the nations through Israel so that we shall see Him for Who He really is.** When we see Him for who He is, even the resistance in our hearts, hindering us to surrender will break. We will find ourselves in total surrender. Many non-believers and many radical men and women against Christianity have rejected Christ because they see a different Christ. They see a European Christ, others see a racist Christ, and others see a tribal Christ or a Christ of certain other negative identity, because of the people who represented Him to them.

As the revelation comes anew through Israel, we will see Christ for who He is and like Paul on Damascus road, it will be instant conversion and it will be the greatest miracle in the history of the Church; the greatest harvest of souls in the history of the Church of Christ.

Because of the above, the forces of darkness are aware of the following:

- (1) they know the above revelation will be released through Israel,
- (2) they know the destiny of Israel will remove the veil from all the nations, and multitudes will surrender to Christ,

Therefore they have one agenda: **The forces of darkness in every nation are not only binding that nation but working against Israel to keep it from the place of releasing that destiny.** We need to pray for Israel, and for our nations in line with Israel's destiny. That is why the conflict over Israel is going to increase and increase and increase as forces of darkness from all over the world zero down on Israel to hinder the revelation - BUT IT SHALL COME TO PASS!

Micah 5:<sup>3-4</sup>

*Therefore will he give them up, until the time that she, which travaileth hath brought forth: then the remnant of his brethren shall return unto the children of Israel. And he shall stand and feed in the strength of the LORD, in the majesty of the name of the LORD his God; and they shall abide: for now shall he be great unto the ends of the earth.*

There will come a time when everyone will abandon Israel until *she who is in labour gives birth*. Other versions say *until she travails to birth*. As everyone gives up Israel, Israel will give themselves to seek God, travail and bring forth. The rest of the Jews elsewhere will return to the land and join themselves to their brothers then *the Lord will stand and shepherd his flock in the strength of the lord ..... and they will live securely for then his greatness will reach to the ends of the earth (NIV)*.

This will not be a miracle for Israel alone but it will open the gates of the nations and the greatness of the Lord will reach the end of the earth. Those days are near - When you watch what is happening in Israel the stage is being set. We do not know how fast it will happen. I remember in year 2000 when we went for the Jerusalem House of Prayer convocation, it was also the day Ariel Sharon went up to the Temple Mount. That is the day the second 'Intafada' (the rebellion/up-rising) began. When we prayed during that convocation with Bro. Tom Hess the Lord spoke to us and said "Take note of this event. This is not a one-off event. This is the beginning of the season."

Indeed it was the beginning of the season. It cast out men like Benjamin Netanyahu, Ehud Barak and led to various developments of where Israel is today. Now Ariel Sharon is out of the picture and what do we see? Hamas is on the scene. Israel is pondering on what to do. The prime minister of Palestine reaffirmed that they will not recognize Israel therefore the stage is set for a real confrontation. These events are not just happening but are Bible prophecies being fulfilled. We all saw the pressure that came upon Ariel Sharon mainly from President George Bush to give up the Promised Land. This same pressure will lead to other nations turning their backs on Israel and the Lord says *they conspire together, all the nations around about to divide up my land, My own inheritance. Therefore I will come and judge them*. This is not something we deal with in human wisdom but through God and God alone. If you use human logic you will judge against what God is doing. In submission we say 'Let Your will be done.'

Let us pray and say *Lord we do not understand the fullness of what You are doing but we want to be on Your side. We do not know how to pray effectively, we ask You to anoint us and inspire us to pray as we should pray. God I know you are doing something I do not understand it. I want to pray according to Your heart. In Christ, the Arabs too have an inheritance in God through Jesus Christ. They are not rejected, but as we were invited to join Israel so have they. Open their eyes to see their inheritance in praying for Israel. When God spoke to Hagar that Ishmael would have 12 princes and said they would be blessed too, He spoke the same to Abraham. If we in Africa have been blessed therefore how much more the ones whom God has blessed directly? May Your Kingdom come to the Jewish people, May your will be done over Israel as it is in heaven – In Jesus name. Amen'*

## ISRAEL PROPHECY

I have put down the prophetic word I received concerning Israel so that, as you read it and by the grace of God, get a burden to begin praying for Israel, pray for the fulfilment of God's prophetic word over that nation – including Bible prophecies and many other prophecies that God has given:

- If you have not been praying for Israel, repent for ignoring Israel for it is our duty as Christians to do so.
- Pray that the Body of Christ, beginning with yourself, will pray for Israel and her destiny as often as you can.
- Pray for the release of Israel's redemptive purpose. As it is fully released, the redemptive purposes of all other nations will also be fully released. Being God's first-born nation, as they receive their inheritance, just as in any family, we shall begin to receive ours too as the followers.
- Pray for the Jews who are as it were, cut off, so that you can become grafted into the family of God. Pray for their salvation especially if you know any by name.
- Pray that God will give you a clear revelation from His Word concerning Israel and her redemptive purpose and destiny.
- Pray for Christian ministries that are involved in the redemption of Israel and Jewish people.

## PROPHECY ABOUT ISRAEL - 1996

*I saw a land and knew this to be Israel. I saw the structures, the buildings, the cities etc. Above all these were rain clouds, heavy rain clouds, there was a storm of wind in the land, and it was blowing across the land like a whirlwind. In some areas it was breaking rocks from off the mountains and it came tumbling down, and stones and huge trees were being carried in the air by this storm. The storm was breaking some of the buildings, and as I was watching the rain was coming down and it was heavy. Buildings and bridges were breaking and I saw people running for shelter, whom I recognized to be Jews and Arabs.*

*I also saw small houses, I understood these to belong to believers in the land and they were standing out beckoning the others to come inside, and they were running in, Jews and Arabs alike. There was no house for Arabs and for Jews. They were all running into the same places. And I was wondering in this vision why the houses are not getting full. They are pushing themselves into the houses and they are not getting full.*

*Then the vision disappeared and I saw a scripture: Micah 5:3,4. NIV. I understood from this when I was in prayer, that the two were different: the storm and the rain. The wind/storm was the power of darkness that was moving from the nations of the world to Israel, and there was going to be a time of great turmoil in Israel. And I understood the rain was God's outpouring of His Spirit, Who is about to be poured out upon the land. The Spirit of God will cause many misconceptions of God to fall apart and God will cause the people of the land, Jews and Arabs, to see the Messiah as He truly is, and many shall give their lives to the Almighty God. It is also going to release a new understanding, a new revelation of Yeshua (His Face) to the nations of the world. Its going to cause to drop theologies etc., we have held, which hindered us from moving in the fullness of God and His purposes, as we behold Him, we should drop all things and commit ourselves to Him.*

*There's going to be a seeing of Who Christ is, so powerfully and vivid. It is going to cause a 100% commitment to Jesus by believers in the nations. Because of that the enemy understands that a breakthrough in Israel is going to cause a breakthrough in the nations, resistance is going to come in from the nations, powers of darkness from every nation of the world.*

*Israel is heading towards a time of great isolation. Everything she trusts in: military power, economic and political/diplomatic power is going to let her down, they are going to try it but it is not going to work. The time is coming that the inhabitants of the land will cry out to God and say: You are our only hope, will You come and help us. O Baruch Haba.... (Matt 23:37 - 39), whatever the cost we need the Messiah. And as the cry goes out in travail (Micah), Israel*



*shall be abandoned until she who travails gives birth. As the travail shall go out of the nation of Israel, God shall cause His Spirit to begin coming down on the land. As this comes the people shall find peace and rest in the Lord. There is going to be a breaking of the bondage of Islam, and of the bondage of Judaism, they'll begin to give their lives to the Lord, and to discover their inheritance in the Lord. The new revelation will be revealed, but how does this relate to us as the nations?*

*There is going to be a shaking because of the bondage that has come over the last 2000 years, in order to break them. In their desperation people will start to discover God, there will be a great harvest of souls. There will be a suffering of judgment because of the way they related to the Jewish people. Many nations will turn away. God calls us to be a holy priesthood in our lands, for the preservation of our nations. The Church itself is going to be shaken drastically, and the understanding of the church as we know it, is going to be torn apart, as it has been a hindrance to receive the fullness of God. The things we held dear are going to let us down. We are going to find a desperate crying out: Lord, we only want you<sup>2</sup>. We will see Jesus in a new way, a new revelation. As Israel suffers isolation and rejection by the nations, the church is going to suffer intense persecution, there is going to be a rejection of people who are standing in the Word of God. Many believers will choose compromise to escape persecution, but those who know their God shall be strong and do exploits. The destinies of our nations lie in the hands of those who are standing as priests (watchmen) before God. To live in the full counsel of God is needed (Him to be the first love of our heart) otherwise we will not be preserved. We are going to provide for the redemption of our land to make a stand for Israel. Judgment is coming over the nations on the issue of Israel, but when we stand with Israel it will release GRACE.*
